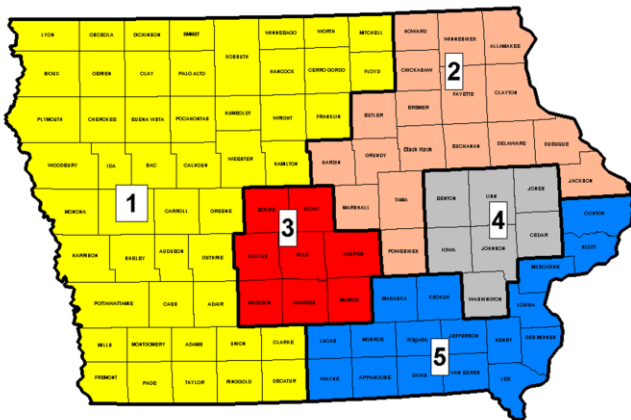
Planning and Service Area (PSA) Designation

Move to approve a map consisting of 5 Planning and Service Areas such as the one presented below.

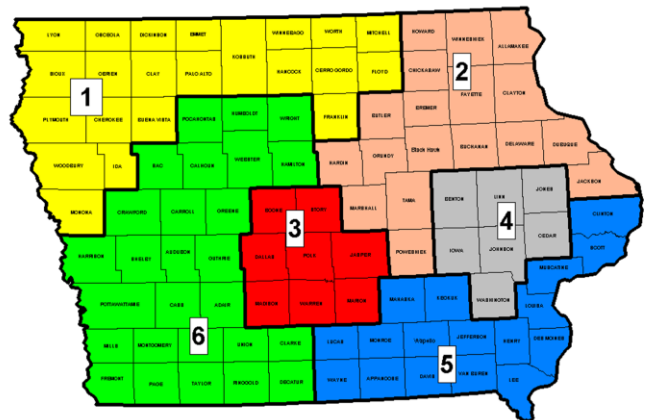
