



**NOTICE OF INTENT TO DESIGNATE PLANNING AND SERVICE AREA BOUNDARIES OR
CHANGE EXISTING PLANNING AND SERVICE AREA BOUNDARIES**

In accordance with the federal Older Americans Act, 42 U.S.C. 3025, and 17 IAC 4, the Iowa Department on Aging is required to divide the state into distinct planning and service areas in order to participate in programs of grants for older individuals.

The Department on Aging is designating or changing planning and service area boundaries due to a change or reduction in the number of planning and service areas as mandated by state law, 2011 Iowa Acts, House File 45, Section 20.

Notice is hereby given that the Iowa Department on Aging intends to designate the following geographic areas as planning and service areas effective July 1, 2012.

Area Two: Allamakee, Black Hawk, Bremer, Buchanan, Butler, Chickasaw, Clayton, Delaware, Dubuque, Fayette, Grundy, Hardin, Howard, Jackson, Marshall, Poweshiek, Tama, and Winneshiek

Area Three: Boone, Dallas, Jasper, Madison, Marion, Polk, Story, and Warren

Area Four: Benton, Cedar, Iowa, Johnson, Jones, Linn, and Washington

Area Five: Appanoose, Clinton, Davis, Des Moines, Henry, Jefferson, Keokuk, Lee, Louisa, Lucas, Mahaska, Monroe, Muscatine, Scott, Van Buren, Wapello, and Wayne
