Congress will consider reauthorization and amendments to the federal Older Americans Act in 2011. In preparation, the Iowa Department on Aging will conduct a Public Hearing soliciting input about the reauthorization. The hearing will be held in multiple remote sites across the state via the Iowa Communication network. A list of remote locations is provided on the second page of this brochure.

The federal Older Americans Act sets out policy goals aimed at improving the lives of individuals age 60 and older. It authorizes the federal Administration on Aging within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. The Act provides federal funds to State Units on Aging (In Iowa, the Department on Aging), which allocates the funds to local Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs) that provide community-based programs to older adults.

To offer as many people as possible time to speak, each participant will be given two minutes to present their prepared comments.
