

IOWA CENTENARIAN STATISTICS

NOVEMBER 4, 2009

According to the US Census 2000*, Iowa had approximately 941 individuals aged 100 years and older ranking Iowa second among the 50 states in percentage of total state population that are centenarians. Of the 676 Iowans 100 years and older who are listed on the Iowa Department on Aging (IDA) Centenarian Registry, 85% are women. 470 of these women reside in facilities and 116 still live in their own home or with relatives. 15% of Iowa Centenarians are men. 53 reside in facilities and 37 live at home or with relatives.
